CONTENT AND OPERATION

The bill designates the following highway and authorizes the Director of Transportation to erect suitable markers along the highway indicating its name:

Designated Name	Highway
"Toledo Firefighters J. Dickman and S. Machcinski Memorial Highway" ¹	The northbound and southbound lanes of Interstate Route 75 between Nebraska Avenue and Monroe Street, in Lucas County

Toledo firefighters James Dickman and Stephen Machcinski were both killed in the line of duty on January 26, 2014, as a result of thermal burns and exposure to carbon monoxide while fighting an apartment fire.
