## CONTENT AND OPERATION

The bill designates the following highway and authorizes the Director of Transportation to erect suitable markers along the highway indicating its name:

Designated Name	Highway
"Senator John W. E. Bowen III Memorial Highway" <sup>1</sup>	The portion of the road known as U.S. Route 33, commencing at the intersection of East Livingston Ave. and College Ave. in the municipal corporation of Columbus and proceeding in a southerly direction to the intersection of U.S. Route 33 with State Route 104, in Franklin County.
