## CONTENT AND OPERATION

The bill designates the following highway and authorizes the Director of Transportation to erect suitable markers along the highway indicating its name:

Designated Name	Highway
"Lt Col Thomas P. Belkofer Memorial Highway" <sup>1</sup>	The eastbound and westbound lanes of State Route 795 between the intersection of that route with Simmons Road and the intersection of that route and Tracy Road, in Wood County.
