This table summarizes how the latest substitute version of the bill differs from the immediately preceding version. It addresses only the topics on which the two versions differ substantively. It does not list topics on which the two bills are substantively the same. The following chart lists the license plates and designations added to the bill.

"Line of Duty Sacrifice" license plate (H.B. 379)	No provision.	Creates the "Line of Duty Sacrifice" license plate, which is available to the immediate family of public safety officers who died in the line of duty (<i>R.C. 4503.435</i>).
"Ohio National Guard Ohio Cross" license plate (H.B. 76)	No provision.	Creates the "Ohio National Guard Ohio Cross" license plate, which is available to recipients of the Ohio National Guard Ohio Cross (<i>R.C. 4503.436</i>).
"KylerStrong Foundation" license plate (S.B. 77)	No provision.	Creates the "KylerStrong Foundation" license plate with a required \$15 contribution to the KylerStrong Foundation to raise awareness of brain cancer caused by diffuse intrinsic pontine glioma and to fund research for the cure of such cancer (<i>R.C. 4501.21 and 4503.4910</i>).

"Gold Ribbon Awareness" license plate (H.B. 306)	No provision.	Creates the "Gold Ribbon Awareness" license plate with a required \$15 contribution to Nationwide Children's Hospital to fund research for the cure of childhood cancers (<i>R.C. 4501.21 and 4503.4911</i>).
"Ottawa National Wildlife Refuge" license plate (H.B. 76)	No provision.	Creates the "Ottawa National Wildlife Refuge" license plate with a required \$20 contribution to the Ottawa National Wildlife Refuge for wildlife preservation purposes (<i>R.C. 4501.21 and 4503.566</i>).
"Post-Traumatic Stress" license plate (H.B. 287)	No provision. No provision.	Creates the "Post-Traumatic Stress" license plate with a required \$40 contribution to be credited to the Post-Traumatic Stress License Plate Contribution Fund, which is created by the bill. Requires the Director of Mental Health and Addiction Services or the Director's designee to use the money in the Fund to issue grants to nonprofit organizations that help victims of violence recover from post-traumatic stress; requires the nonprofit organizations to use the grant money to provide services to victims; and requires the Director to approve the nonprofit organizations that will receive grants and the amounts paid to each nonprofit organization. (<i>R.C. 4503.593.</i>)
"Pelotonia" license plate (H.B. 313)	No provision.	Creates the "Pelotonia" license plate with a required \$15 contribution to Pelotonia for supporting cancer research (<i>R.C. 4501.21 and 4503.594</i>).

"Juvenile Diabetes Research Foundation" license plate (S.B. 77)	No provision.	Redirects contributions collected for the license plate to the Central Ohio Chapter of the Juvenile Diabetes Research Foundation and then requires the Central Ohio Chapter to distribute the contributions to the various chapters of the Foundation based on the geographic territory of the person who paid the contribution. Current law directs the contributions to each of the various chapters directly from the Registrar of Motor Vehicles (<i>R.C. 4501.21 and 4503.733</i>).
"Medina County" license plate (S.B. 230)	No provision.	Creates the "Medina County" license plate with a required \$15 contribution to the Medina County Historical Society for distribution between various historical societies and museums in Medina County (<i>R.C. 4501.21 and 4503.764</i>).
"Padua Franciscan High School" license plate (H.B. 417)	No provision.	<p>Creates the "Padua Franciscan High School" license plate with a required \$30 contribution, half of which must go towards tuition assistance and half of which must be used to pay the expenses the High School incurs in providing services that assist in developing or maintaining the mental and emotional well-being of the students (<i>R.C. 4501.21 and 4503.873</i>).</p> <p>Requires the High School to produce and submit an annual report to the Department of Mental Health regarding the amount received in contributions, an itemized list of expenditures, and the total percentage of spending used to provide services to students that assist in developing and maintaining mental and emotional well-being (failure to submit the report will result in the contributions being redirected to the GRF) (<i>R.C. 4503.772</i>).</p>

"Cuyahoga Heights Schools" license plate (H.B. 288)	No provision. No provision.	Creates the "Cuyahoga Heights Schools" license plate with a required \$30 contribution to pay the expenses the School District incurs in providing services that assist in developing or maintaining the mental and emotional well-being of the students (R.C. 4501.21 and 4503.878). Requires the School District to produce and submit an annual report to the Department of Mental Health regarding the amount received in contributions, an itemized list of expenditures, and the total percentage of spending used to provide services to students that assist in developing and maintaining mental and emotional well-being (failure to submit the report will result in the contributions being redirected to the GRF) (R.C. 4503.772).
"West Technical High School Alumni" license plate (H.B. 404)	No provision.	Creates the "West Technical High School Alumni" license plate with a required \$20 contribution to be used by the West Technical High School Alumni Association for activities sponsored by the Association (R.C. 4501.21 and 4503.879).
"Kenston Local Schools" license plate (H.B. 227)	No provision.	Creates the "Kenston Local Schools" license plate with a required \$30 contribution to pay the expenses the school district incurs in providing services that assist in developing or maintaining a culture of environmental responsibility and an innovative science, technology, engineering, art, and math curriculum (R.C. 4501.21 and 4503.88).

"Lions Club" license plate (H.B. 321)	No provision.	Creates the "Lions Club" license plate with a required \$15 contribution to the Ohio Lions Foundation for charitable and educational purposes (<i>R.C. 4501.21 and 4503.891</i>).
"Hudson City Schools" license plate (H.B. 264)	No provision.	Creates the "Hudson City Schools" license plate with a required \$30 contribution and prohibits the School District from using the contributions it receives for any political purpose (<i>R.C. 4501.21 and 4503.892</i>).
"Cuyahoga Valley Career Center" license plate (H.B. 88)	No provision. No provision.	Creates the "Cuyahoga Valley Career Center" license plate with a required \$30 contribution to pay the expenses the Center incurs in providing services that assist in developing or maintaining the mental and emotional well-being of the students (<i>R.C. 4501.21 and 4503.905</i>). Requires the Center to produce and submit an annual report to the Department of Mental Health regarding the amount received in contributions, an itemized list of expenditures, and the total percentage of spending used to provide services to students that assist in developing and maintaining mental and emotional well-being (failure to submit the report will result in the contributions being redirected to the GRF) (<i>R.C. 4503.772</i>).
"Stow-Munroe Falls City Schools" license plate (H.B. 265)	No provision.	Creates the "Stow-Munroe Falls City Schools" license plate with a required \$30 contribution and prohibits the School District from using the contributions it receives for any political purpose (<i>R.C. 4501.21 and 4503.906</i>).

"Henry T. Beatty Memorial Picnic Area" (H.B. 316)	No provision.	Designates the picnic area located northwest of the intersection of Titus Road and Division Street in Kelleys Island State Park (<i>R.C. 1546.30</i>).
"Lt Col Thomas P. Belkofer Memorial Highway" (S.B. 134)	No provision.	Designates the eastbound and westbound lanes of State Route (SR) 795 between the intersection of that route with Simmons Road and the intersection of that route and Tracy Road in Wood County (<i>R.C. 5534.151</i>).
"Poland Township Police Officer Charles K. Yates Memorial Highway" (S.B. 167)	No provision.	Designates the eastbound and westbound lanes of U.S. Route (USR) 224, between the intersection of USR 224 and Diana Drive and the Pennsylvania border in Mahoning County (<i>R.C. 5334.411</i>).
"Poland Township Officer Richard E. Becker Memorial Highway" (S.B. 166)	No provision.	Designates the portion of SR 170, running in a northwesterly and southeasterly direction between the southeastern border of the municipal corporation of Poland and the northwestern border of Springfield Township in Mahoning County (<i>R.C. 5534.412</i>).
"Michael J. Aselage Memorial Highway" (H.B. 325)	No provision.	Designates a portion of SR 705, commencing at the intersection with Sawmill Road and proceeding in a southerly and easterly direction to the intersection with Eilerman Road in Shelby County (<i>R.C. 5534.413</i>).
"Toledo Firefighters J. Dickman and S. Machcinski Memorial Highway" (H.B. 324)	No provision.	Designates the northbound and southbound lanes of I-75 between Nebraska Avenue and Monroe Street in Lucas County (<i>R.C. 5534.48</i>).
"Captain Michael Palumbo Memorial Highway" (S.B. 161)	No provision.	Designates the northbound and southbound lanes of I-271 from mile marker 28 to mile marker 32, in Cuyahoga County (<i>R.C. 5534.491</i>).

"Patrolman Jason Gresko Memorial Highway" (H.B. 330)	No provision.	Designates the northbound and southbound lanes of SR 91 in the municipal corporation of Willoughby in Lake County (<i>R.C. 5534.494</i>).
"Carl and Louis Stokes Opportunity Corridor" (H.B. 83)	No provision.	Designates the planned boulevard that will run in a northeasterly and southwesterly direction from the intersection of E. 55th Street and I-490 to approximately the intersection of E. 105th Street and Chester Avenue in the municipal corporation of Cleveland (<i>R.C. 5534.56</i>).
"Harry Meshel Memorial Highway" (H.B. 376)	No provision.	Designates the portion of the road known as USR 422, running in a northwesterly and southeasterly direction, between the intersections of USR 62 and 5th Avenue, in the municipal corporation of Youngstown (<i>R.C. 5534.57</i>).
"Ralph Regula Memorial Highway" (H.B. 435)	No provision.	Designates USR 30 between 1,500 feet west of mile marker 19.8 and 1 mile east of mile marker 11.6, in Wayne County (<i>R.C. 5534.58</i>).
"Sgt. Jordan Marshall Memorial Highway" (H.B. 358)	No provision.	Designates the portion of SR 19, running in a northerly and southerly direction, between the intersections of West Bier Road and North Railroad Street, in Ottawa County (<i>R.C. 5534.631</i>).
"Ohio Valley Vietnam Veterans Memorial Highway" (H.B. 303)	No provision.	Designates the northbound and southbound lanes of SR 7 from the southern boundary of the municipal corporation of Martins Ferry to the northern boundary of the Village of Bellaire in Belmont County (<i>R.C. 5534.64</i>).
"Sergeant James F. Allen III Memorial Highway" (H.B. 22)	No provision.	Designates the eastbound and westbound lanes of SR 261 between the intersections of SR 94 and SR 21 in Medina and Summit counties (<i>R.C. 5534.69</i>).

"Lance Corporal Christopher J. Dyer USMC, Lima Co, 3/25 Marines Memorial Highway" (S.B. 185)	No provision.	Designates the northbound and southbound lanes of I-75, from mile marker 13 to mile marker 15, in Hamilton County (<i>R.C. 5534.76</i>).
"Army Specialist Danny Raymond King Memorial Highway" (H.B. 140)	No provision.	Designates the eastbound and westbound lanes of SR 32 between the intersections of SR 134 and Corboy Road in Brown and Highland counties (<i>R.C. 5534.78</i>).
"Staff Sergeant Paul C. Mardis Jr. Memorial Highway" (H.B. 212)	No provision.	Designates a portion of SR 16, running in a northerly and southerly direction between the municipal corporation of Coshocton and Township Road 279, in Coshocton County (<i>R.C. 5534.801</i>).
"SGT David Sexton Memorial Highway" (H.B. 136)	No provision.	Designates the northbound and southbound lanes of SR 61 between the intersections of SR 113 and Mason Road in Erie County (<i>R.C. 5534.802</i>).
"SGT Glen Millinger Memorial Highway" (H.B. 136)	No provision.	Designates the northbound and southbound lanes of Benton-Carroll Road between the intersections of SR 163 and West Bier Road in Ottawa County (<i>R.C. 5534.803</i>).
"Army Specialist David Lee Bingamon Memorial Highway" (H.B. 257)	No provision.	Designates the northbound and southbound lanes of USR 68 between the intersection of that route and Waits Road and the intersection of that route and Clements Road, in Brown County (<i>R.C. 5534.804</i>).
"Women Veterans Bridge" (S.B. 212)	No provision.	Designates the bridge on Mahoning Ave. and spanning SR 11, located in Austintown Township in Mahoning County (<i>R.C. 5534.84</i>).
"The American Legion Highway" (H.B. 325)	No provision.	Designates a portion of the eastbound and westbound lanes of SR 703, between the intersection with SR 29, in Mercer County, and the intersection with SR 364, in Auglaize County (<i>R.C. 5534.86</i>).

"Private First Class Donald E. Byrum Memorial Highway" (H.B. 325)	No provision.	Designates a portion of the northbound and southbound lanes of SR 118, between the intersection with Elroy Ansonia Road and the intersection with Beamsville-Union City Road, in Darke County (<i>R.C. 5534.87</i>).
"U.S. Air Force Staff Sergeant Yvonne Marie Fair Memorial Highway" (S.B. 78)	No provision.	Designates the southbound lane of SR 7 from mile marker 12 to mile marker 8 in Jefferson County only (<i>R.C. 5534.88</i>).
"Officer Bill Johnson Memorial Highway" (H.B. 100)	No provision.	Designates the portion of SR 73, running in an easterly and westerly direction between the intersections of SR 741 and I-75, in Warren County only (<i>R.C. 5534.93</i>).
"Roy Rogers Happy Trails Highway" (H.B. 311)	No provision.	Designates the portion of the road known as SR 348, running in an easterly and westerly direction, between the intersections of that route with SR 104 and SR 73, in Scioto County (<i>R.C. 5534.95</i>).
"Frank Watson Memorial Highway" (H.B. 375)	No provision.	Designates the portion of the road known as I-680, running in an easterly and westerly direction, between the intersections of Market Street and Glenwood Avenue, in the municipal corporation of Youngstown (<i>R.C. 5534.97</i>).
