## CONTENT AND OPERATION

### "Medina County" license plate

The bill creates the following license plate:<sup>1</sup>

<b>Special License Plate</b>	<b>Medina County</b> license plate, which is inscribed with identifying words or markings that are designed by representatives of the Medina County Historical Society and that are approved by the Registrar of Motor Vehicles.
<b>Recipients</b>	Available to all applicants.
<b>Eligible Vehicles</b>	Any passenger car, noncommercial motor vehicle, recreational vehicle, or other vehicle approved by the Registrar.
<b>Contribution, Additional BMV Fee, and Use of Contribution</b>	\$15 contribution directed to the Medina County Historical Society to be distributed between the various historical societies and museums in Medina County. <sup>2</sup>  \$10 additional administrative BMV fee.
<b>Requirements for Issuance</b>	(1) Submission of an application;  (2) Payment of the regular license tax, any local tax, contribution, administrative fee, any special reserved license plate fee if necessary; and

	(3) Compliance with all other relevant laws relating to motor vehicle registration.
<b>Combined with Special Reserved License Plate</b>	May be combined with a special reserved license plate as provided in current law.
<b>Applicability of License Plate Termination Procedures</b>	Procedures governing the termination of nonstandard license plates apply. <sup>3</sup>
