Synopsis of Senate Committee Amendments*

132nd General Assembly
(S. Judiciary)

- Modified the provision of the House-passed version of the bill that permits a tactical medical professional to carry a firearm while on duty if the professional has received firearms training and is authorized to carry firearms by the professional's law enforcement agency to require that the agency's authorization must *specifically* authorize the professional to carry a firearm while on duty.
- Added provisions that authorize a coroner's investigator to carry a firearm while on duty if the investigator has received firearms training and is authorized to carry firearms by the county coroner the investigator serves and that provide for firearms training for the investigators.
