CONTENT AND OPERATION

The act designates May as "Neurofibromatosis Awareness Month."¹

Neurofibromatosis is a genetic disorder that causes tumors to form on nerve tissue. The tumors are usually noncancerous, but can become cancerous. Complications of neurofibromatosis include hearing loss, learning impairment, heart and blood vessel problems, loss of vision, and severe pain.²
