BILL SUMMARY

 Reduces from four to two the minimum number of precinct election officials per precinct in a multi-precinct voting location in which electronic pollbooks are used.

CONTENT AND OPERATION

Minimum number of precinct election officials

In a voting location that serves more than one precinct, if electronic pollbooks are used at that location, the bill reduces the minimum number of precinct election officials who must be appointed from four per precinct to two.

Additionally, the bill makes a technical correction to change the term "presiding judge" to "voting location manager," which is the term currently used in the Election Law.¹
