CONTENT AND OPERATION

The bill designates the following highway and authorizes the Director of Transportation to erect suitable markers along the highway indicating its name:

Designated Name	Highway
"Sgt. Herman Zerger Highway" ¹	The eastbound and westbound lanes of State Route 78 from the border of Monroe and Noble counties to the intersection of State Route 78 and State Route 26 in Monroe County.

COMMENT

Sergeant Herman Zerger is an army veteran who served in World War II and was a prisoner of war. He also served as a Special Duty Sheriff in Monroe County and was elected to five consecutive terms as Central Township Trustee.
