CONTENT AND OPERATION

The bill designates the following highway and authorizes the Director of Transportation to erect suitable markers along the highway indicating its name:

Designated Name	Highway
"Lt. Harry L. Martin Memorial Highway" ¹	The eastbound and westbound lanes of U.S. Route 30, between the intersections of State Route 231 and State Route 598, in Wyandot and Crawford counties.

COMMENT

Lt. Harry L. Martin was a United States Marine Corps officer who was posthumously awarded the Congressional Medal of Honor for service and heroism during the Battle of Iwo Jima in 1945.
