## CONTENT AND OPERATION

The bill designates the following highway and authorizes the Director of Transportation to erect suitable markers along the highway indicating its name:

Designated Name	Highway
"Lance Corporal James Sprowl Memorial Highway" <sup>1</sup>	The northbound and southbound lanes of State Route 99, between the intersections of County Road 64 and County Road 119, in Huron County.
