## **Fiscal Note & Local Impact Statement**

**Bill:** H.B. 690 of the 132nd G.A. **Status:** As Reported by House Transportation and Public Safety

Sponsor: Rep. Ingram Local Impact Statement Procedure Required: No

Subject: Designates the Hamilton County Veterans Memorial Highway

The Ohio Department of Transportation (ODOT) will incur about \$350 to \$400 in costs for producing and installing a set of memorial signs for this memorial highway. Specifically, the bill designates the stretch on I-75 within Hamilton County between where it intersects with Crescentville Road and the Kentucky border as the Hamilton County Veterans Memorial Highway. Since the designated portion of highway is an interstate route, ODOT would be responsible for producing and installing the signs. Two markers are usually installed, one in each direction at each location. Once a set of signs is installed, there are typically no maintenance costs unless the signs are damaged. Signs usually need to be replaced every 12 to 15 years.
