Restoration of solar energy credit prohibition

Restores the prohibition against a qualified solar resource obtaining a renewable energy credit usable to meet the renewable portfolio standards for megawatt hours for which it has already received a solar energy credit under the program created under H.B. 6 of the 133rd General Assembly and administered by the Ohio Air Quality Development Authority.

Changes references in the renewable energy credit law in Revised Code section 4928.645 from “qualifying *renewable* resources” and “*renewable* energy credit” to “qualifying *solar* resource” and “*solar* energy credit” to conform with the bill’s other provisions.
