S.B. 109 of the 134th General Assembly

Additional appropriations

Adds or modifies the following appropriations in the bill:

Agency	Total appropriation amount	Details
Development Services Agency	\$180 million (Fund 5CV1)	Makes 100% of the \$180 million in appropriations from Fund 5CV1, instead of appropriating \$30 million from GRF and \$150 million from Fund 5CV1.
Department of Developmental Disabilities	\$50 million (Federal Fund Group Fund 3A40)	Adds \$50 million to the Medicaid Services line item.
Department of Job and Family Services	\$319.2 million (Federal Fund Group)	Increases and modifies the appropriations to JFS as follows: <ol style="list-style-type: none">\$44.8 million (Fund 3H70) for payments to child care providers (licensed daycare centers and Type A and Type B family daycare homes) for ongoing infrastructure costs and to help with various COVID-related expenses.\$67.4 million (Fund 3H70) for child care staff and administrator stipends, retroactive to October 1, 2020.Up to \$55 million (Fund 3H70) for direct care payments to licensed providers serving children eligible for publicly funded child care.

		<p>4. \$21 million (Fund 3840) to support the Pandemic-Electronic Benefit Transfer Program to provide children with SNAP benefits.</p> <p>5. \$10 million (Fund 3A20) to support food banks.</p> <p>6. \$26 million (Fund 3N00) to provide Youth Services Program support in the Educational Training Voucher Program, the Chaffee Independent Living Program, and the Bridges Program.</p> <p>7. \$41 million (Fund 3V40) to support the Unemployment Compensation and Pandemic Unemployment Assistance Programs.</p> <p>8. \$34 million (Fund 3V60) to the TANF Block Grant to be used to provide support to counties consistent with federal guidelines.</p> <p>9. \$20 million (Fund 3F01) to the Medicaid Program Support-Federal line item.</p>
