## Bill Analysis

### SUMMARY

- Specifies that the database of individuals registered, and personal information of registered individuals contained within the database, for the Vax-A-Million campaign is confidential and is not a public record under Ohio's Public Records Law.
- Declares an emergency, meaning that the bill takes effect immediately.

### DETAILED ANALYSIS

#### Vax-A-Million database information

The bill specifies that the database of individuals registered, and personal information of registered individuals contained within the database, for the Vax-A-Million campaign is confidential and is not a public record under Ohio's Public Records Law.<sup>1</sup>

The bill defines "personal information" to include the name, electronic mail address, telephone number, street address, and vaccine location information of individuals who registered for the Vax-A-Million campaign, and includes the name, electronic mail address, and telephone number of a parent or guardian.

The bill also defines the "Vax-A-Million campaign" to be the campaign held in 2021 consisting of a series of statewide drawings to provide prizes to individuals who receive a COVID-19 vaccination.<sup>2</sup>

## Emergency clause

The bill declares an emergency, meaning that it takes effect immediately and is not subject to the referendum.<sup>3</sup>
