### DETAILED ANALYSIS

The bill designates the following highway and authorizes the Director of Transportation to erect suitable markers along the highway indicating its name:

<b>Designated Name</b>	"Jessie Gooding Highway" <sup>1</sup>
<b>Highway</b>	The westbound and eastbound lanes of S.R. 35 between Diamond Mill Road and South Union Road, in Montgomery County.
<b>Other Information</b>	Jessie Gooding is a Dayton resident and civil rights activist. Gooding served 20 years as president of the local NAACP and was inducted into the Ohio Civil Rights Commission's Hall of Fame in 2014.
