DETAILED ANALYSIS

The bill designates the following highway and authorizes the Director of Transportation to erect suitable markers along the highway indicating its name:

Designated Name	"Army Sgt. Herbert C. Linville Memorial Highway" ¹
Highway	The portion of S.R. 29 between mile marker 20 and mile marker 25, in Auglaize County
Other Information	Sgt. Linville served during World War II in the 37 th Infantry Division – known as the "Buckeye Division." Sgt. Linville died on July 11, 1943, while overtaking Japanese forces on New Georgia, Solomon Islands.
