### DETAILED ANALYSIS

The bill designates the following highway, and authorizes the Director of Transportation to erect suitable markers along the highway indicating its name:

<b>Designated Name</b>	"Corporal John E. Ruch Memorial Highway" <sup>1</sup>
<b>Highway</b>	The northeastbound and southwestbound lanes of U.S. Route 20 between Center Road and Gerald Road, in Ashtabula County
<b>Other Information</b>	Corporal John E. Ruch, a member of the Ohio State Highway Patrol, was killed in an automobile accident during a high-speed pursuit on March 4, 1942.
