## **DETAILED ANALYSIS**

License Plate	<b>Lakeside Chautauqua</b> license plate, which must display an appropriate logo and words selected by the representatives of Lakeside Chautauqua Foundation and approved by the Registrar of Motor Vehicles. <sup>1</sup>	
Recipients	Available to all applicants.	
Eligible Vehicles	Any passenger car, noncommercial motor vehicle, recreational vehicle, or other vehicle approved by the Registrar.	
Contribution; Additional BMV Fee; Use of Contribution	<ul> <li>\$25 required contribution.</li> <li>\$10 additional administrative BMV fee.</li> <li>Contributions must be paid to the Lakeside Chautauqua Foundation. The foundation must use these contributions for the conservation and preservation of Lake Erie and the surrounding ecosystem.<sup>2</sup></li> </ul>	
Requirements for Issuance	<ol> <li>Submission of an application;</li> <li>Payment of the regular license tax, any local tax, contribution, administrative fee, any special reserved license plate fee if necessary; and</li> <li>Compliance with all other relevant laws relating to motor vehicle registration.</li> </ol>
