Centers for Civics, Culture, and Society		
Establishes:		No provision.
1.	The Salmon P. Chase Center for Civics, Culture, and Society at Ohio State University;	
2.	The Institute of American Constitutional Thought and Leadership at the University of Toledo; and	
3.	Centers for Civics, Culture, and Society at each of the University of Cincinnati, Miami University, and Cleveland State University (<i>R.C. 3335.39, 3339.06,</i> <i>3344.07, 3361.06, and 3364.07</i>).	
Appropriates:		No provision.
1.	\$5 million in both FYs 2024 and 2025 for the Salmon P. Chase Center;	
2.	\$1 million in both FYs 2024 and 2025 for the Institute of American Constitutional Thought and Leadership; and	
3.	\$2 million in both of FYs 2024 and 2025 for each of the Centers at University of Cincinnati, Miami University, and Cleveland State University <i>(Section 3)</i> .

Prenatal-to-Five Early Childhood to Post-Secondary	Regional Partnerships Program
No provision.	Establishes the Prenatal-to-Five Early Childhood to Post-Secondary Regional Partnerships Program to support early childhood to post-secondary regional partnerships throughout Ohio (<i>R.C. 3301.85</i>).
No provision.	Appropriates \$2 million in FY 2025 to support the program (Section 3).
State Board of Education Licensure Fund	
No provision.	Requires the Director of Budget and Management to transfer \$4,660,500 from the General Revenue Fund to the State Board of Education Licensure Fund on the bill's effective date or as soon as possible thereafter <i>(Section 5)</i> .
