## **DETAILED ANALYSIS**

The bill designates the following highway and authorizes the Director of Transportation to erect suitable markers along the highway indicating its name:

Designated Name	"Lance Corporal James F. Kimple Memorial Highway" <sup>1</sup>
Highway	The portion of U.S. Route 33, running southeast and northwest, between Coonpath Road NW and Pickerington Road NW, in Fairfield County
Other Information	Lance Cpl. James F. Kimple enlisted as a U.S. Marine in 2004. He was killed by a roadside bomb on May 2, 2008, while supporting combat operations during Operation Iraqi Freedom.
