DETAILED ANALYSIS

The bill designates the following highway and authorizes the Director of Transportation to erect suitable markers along the highway indicating its name:

| Highway | U.S. Route 62, running in an easterly and westerly direction, between Western Avenue and South Mahoning Avenue in Alliance, Ohio. |
| Other Information | Patrolman James P. Gardner was killed on February 28, 1948, in a patrol car crash at age 24 while pursuing a traffic violator near Alliance on U.S. Route 62. Prior to his employment with the Ohio State Highway Patrol, Gardner was honorably discharged after serving for three and a half years with the U.S. Navy in World War II. |
