The table above summarizes details about the memorial highway designated by the bill, including the location and the entities responsible for installing the signs. The cost of producing and installing each set of two signs is approximately \$1,400. Signs usually need to be replaced every 12 to 15 years.

The Ohio Department of Transportation (ODOT) produces the signs and is often responsible for the installation. However, if the memorial highway is located within municipal boundaries, as is the case with this bill, each of the municipalities may install the signs and may need to reimburse ODOT for the production costs.
