131st General Assembly (Community & Family Advancement)

This table summarizes how the latest substitute version of the bill (LSC 131 0695-1) differs from the immediately preceding version (As Introduced). It addresses only the topics on which the two versions differ substantively. It does not list topics on which the two bills are substantively the same.

Topic	Previous Version (As Introduced)	Sub. Version (LSC 131 0695-1)
Allegation of dependence	Requires a public children services agency (PCSA) to treat a service provider's report as an allegation that the child is a dependent child (R.C. 3109.81(C)).	No provision.
Temporary placement investigation: Home safety study	Requires a PCSA to perform a home safety study during an investigation (R.C. 3109.81(C)).	Provides for a PCSA to perform a home safety study during an investigation if the records check warrants it (R.C. 3109.81(C)(1)).
Temporary placement investigation: Requirements	Provides that the PCSA must investigate the child's temporary placement with the attorney in fact in accordance with statutory law and Department of Job and Family Services rules governing PCSA investigations (R.C. 3109.81(C)).	No provision.
Temporary placement investigation: Short-term period exception	No provision.	Provides that a PCSA is not required to investigate the temporary placement of a child for a designated short-term period due to a vacation, school-sponsored function or activity, or because of a parent's incarceration, military
