BILL SUMMARY

- Designates both the eastbound and westbound bridges that will span the Cuyahoga River in Cuyahoga County and be part of Interstate Highway 90 as the "George V. Voinovich Bridge."

CONTENT AND OPERATION

The bill designates *both* the eastbound and westbound bridges that will span the Cuyahoga River in Cuyahoga County and be part of Interstate Highway 90 as the "George V. Voinovich Bridge." Current law refers only to *the* bridge that will span the Cuyahoga River.¹

The bill authorizes the Director of Transportation to erect suitable markers on the bridges or along their approaches indicating their name.

COMMENT

George V. Voinovich served as a member of the Ohio House of Representatives from 1967 to 1971, Mayor of Cleveland from 1979 to 1986, Governor of Ohio from 1991 to 1998, and as United States Senator from 1999 to 2011.
