BILL SUMMARY

- Designates October 16 as George Washington Williams Day.

CONTENT AND OPERATION

The bill designates the 16th day of October as George Washington Williams Day in commemoration of the Civil War veteran, minister, politician, lawyer, and historian who was born on that day in 1849. The bill encourages elementary and secondary schools in Ohio to observe this day by discussing the life of George Washington Williams.
