BILL SUMMARY

The bill designates the following roadway and authorizes the Director of Transportation to erect suitable markers along the roadway:

The "Private First Class William "Brent" Turner U.S.M.C. Memorial Highway" ¹	The portion of S.R. 72, running in a northerly and southerly direction between the intersection of S.R. 72 and U.S. 42 and the interchange of S.R. 72 and S.R. 343 in Greene County
