## BILL SUMMARY

- Designates the portion of S.R. 72, running in a northerly and southerly direction between the intersection of S.R. 72 and U.S. 42 and the interchange of S.R. 72 and S.R. 343 in Greene County, as the "Private First Class William "Brent" Turner U.S.M.C. Memorial Highway."
- Authorizes the Director of Transportation to erect suitable markers along the highway indicating its name.<sup>1</sup>

Private First Class William "Brent" Turner died on April 7, 1970, while serving as a Marine in Vietnam.
