Detailed Fiscal Analysis

The bill states that the General Assembly intends to review various aspects of the value-added progress dimension used on the state report card ratings for school districts and schools. The bill has no effect on public revenues or expenditures.

In FY 2016 and FY 2017, \$4.9 million in annual GRF funding is specifically appropriated to the Ohio Department of Education for the current accountability system and report cards, portions of which are used to incorporate the value-added progress dimension into district and school report card ratings and to train educators and specialists on the use of the data to improve instruction and student learning. Additional appropriation is used for data collection. For additional details regarding the value-added progress dimension, please refer to the LSC Bill Analysis.
