## **BILL SUMMARY**

- Prohibits the sale of cosmetics or personal care products containing microbeads, which are micro-polymer particles, less than five millimeters in diameter, that are made of synthetic or semi-synthetic polymeric materials.
- Establishes a civil fine of up to \$1,000 for each day of violation and, for a subsequent violation, a civil fine of up to \$2,500 for each day of violation.
- Authorizes the Director of Agriculture to adopt rules necessary to implement the bill.

## **CONTENT AND OPERATION**

### **Microbeads**

The bill prohibits the sale of cosmetics or personal care products containing microbeads.<sup>1</sup> Microbeads are micro-polymer particles, less than five millimeters in diameter, that are made of synthetic or semi-synthetic polymeric materials such as polyethylene, polypropylene, or a combination of such polymers. Personal care products are consumer products manufactured for use in personal hygiene and beautification, such as anti-bacterial soaps, lotions, and toothpastes.<sup>2</sup> A person who violates the bill is subject to a civil fine of up to \$1,000 for each day of violation<sup>3</sup> and, for a subsequent violation, a civil fine of up to \$2,500 for each day of violation.<sup>3</sup>

The bill authorizes the Director of Agriculture to adopt rules that the Director considers necessary to implement the bill.<sup>4</sup>
