Subject: Prohibits disclosure of school disciplinary actions on college admission applications

The bill prohibits public and private institutions of higher education from requiring a student to disclose on its admission application any disciplinary action taken against the student by the student's primary or secondary schools, including any suspension or expulsion. However, the bill does not prohibit primary and secondary schools from including that information as part of the student records sent in an application packet to an institution of higher education. The bill may result in a negligible increase in the administrative expenses of state institutions of higher education to remove the applicable disciplinary history questions from admission applications.
