CONTENT AND OPERATION

"Army Distinguished Service Cross," "Navy Cross," "Air Force Cross," and "Coast Guard Cross" license plates

The bill creates the following license plates:¹

Special License Plate	Army Distinguished Service Cross, Navy Cross, Air Force Cross, and Coast Guard Cross license plates, which contain an illustration of the appropriate award and are inscribed with the words "Army Distinguished Service Cross Medal Recipient," "Navy Cross Medal Recipient," "Air Force Cross Medal Recipient," or "Coast Guard Cross Medal Recipient," as applicable.
Recipients	Available to any person who has been awarded one of the specified medals.
Eligible Vehicles	Any passenger car, noncommercial motor vehicle, recreational vehicle, or other vehicle approved by the Registrar of Motor Vehicles.
Contribution, Additional BMV Fee, and Use of Contribution	None.
Requirements for Issuance	(1) Submission of an application; (2) Documentary evidence of receipt of the award, as required by the Registrar; (3) Payment of the regular license tax, any local tax, any special reserved license plate fee if necessary; and

	(4) Compliance with all other relevant laws relating to motor vehicle registration.
Combined with Special Reserved License Plate	May be combined with a special reserved license plate provided in current law.
Applicability of License Plate Termination Procedures	Procedures governing the termination of nonstandard license plates do not apply. ²
