This table summarizes how the latest substitute version of the bill differs from the immediately preceding version. It addresses only the topics on which the two versions differ substantively. It does not list topics on which the two bills are substantively the same.

<b>Title IV-A program</b>	Includes the Kinship Care Navigator Program as a Title IV-A program funded in part with Temporary Assistance for Needy Families block grant funds <i>(R.C. 5101.80(A)(4)(h)).</i>	No provision.
<b>Amendment to state plan</b>	Requires the Director of Job and Family Services (ODJFS), not later than one year after the bill's effective date, to submit an amendment to the state plan to the U.S. Secretary of Health and Human Services to make federal payments for kinship care navigators under Title IV-A <i>(R.C. 5101.855(A)).</i>	No provision.

Topic	Previous Version (As Introduced)	Sub. Version (L_132_0516-2)
<b>State funding</b>	No provision.	Requires the Kinship Care Navigator Program to be funded to the extent that General Revenue Funds have been appropriated by the General Assembly for the Program <i>(R.C. 5101.855(A)(1))</i> .
<b>Federal funding</b>	No provision.	Requires the Director of ODJFS to take any action necessary to obtain federal funds under Title IV-E of the Social Security Act for the Kinship Care Navigator Program <i>(R.C. 5101.855(A)(2))</i> .
<b>Kinship Caregiver Program</b> <i>(R.C. 5101.855(B))</i>	Specifies that ODJFS must pay for the full nonfederal share for the Kinship Caregiver Program.	Specifies that ODJFS must pay for the Kinship <i>Care Navigator</i> Program rather than the <i>Caregiver</i> Program.

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
