## Fiscal Note & Local Impact Statement

**Bill:** S.B. 258 of the 132nd G.A.

**Status:** As Introduced

**Sponsor:** Sen. Schiavoni

**Local Impact Statement Procedure Required:** No

**Subject:** School safety grants

---

The bill appropriates \$34.2 million from the GRF in both FY 2018 and FY 2019 to award grants to school districts for school safety purposes. The maximum amount of the grants ranges between \$25,000 and \$100,000 per year depending on the number of students enrolled in the district, as shown in the table below. School districts desiring the funds must apply to the Ohio Department of Education (ODE) using a form prescribed by the State Board of Education. Thus, the administrative duties of the State Board and ODE will increase to establish the form, criteria, and procedures necessary to consider and approve applications and to administer the grant program, respectively.

Less than 1,000 students	Up to \$25,000
Between 1,000 and 2,000 students	Up to \$50,000
More than 2,000 but less than 10,000 students	Up to \$75,000
10,000 or more students	Up to \$100,000
